GETTING TO AND AROUND LOS ANGELES

The Getty Villa is located at 17985 Pacific Coast Highway in Pacific Palisades, California, one mile north of Sunset Boulevard. It is approximately 25 miles west of downtown Los Angeles and 18 miles north of Los Angeles International Airport. For more information see <http://www.getty.edu/visit/hours/>

Driving Directions:

From Los Angeles, take the I-10 (Santa Monica Freeway) west until it turns into Route 1 (Pacific Coast Highway) going north along the Pacific Ocean. Continue on Route 1 for approximately five miles to the Getty Villa. Please note that visitors must approach the Getty Villa from the south. Access to the Getty Villa entrance is only from the northbound right-hand lane of Pacific Coast Highway (PCH). Turning left across PCH is illegal and any attempt to enter the site via Coastline Drive is not permitted.

Entry and Parking:

The Getty Villa Visitor Services department has arranged a ticket system that you will access online to print one ticket that will be good for all three days. Each person needs their own ticket, regardless of whether they carpool or not. When you enter the \$10 parking fee will be waived. The web link and password will be sent to you with your conference confirmation.

If you eschew cars:

Metro Bus 534 stops at Coastline Drive and Pacific Coast Highway directly across from the Getty Villa entrance. To find the route that is best for you, call (800) COMMUTE or use the Trip Planner on www.metro.net, the web site of the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority.

To get to the Los Angeles County Museum of Art from the Getty Villa:

Return south on the PCH, which turns into the I-10 Santa Monica Freeway. Take this to the Fairfax Blvd. exit 17B. Take Fairfax north to Wilshire Blvd. and turn right. The museum is located at 5905 Wilshire Blvd. Parking is available in the new 6th Street parking garage, located just east of Fairfax Avenue (continue north past Wilshire; turn right on 6th). The charge is \$7 and may be prepaid at all Welcome Centers, with credit cards now accepted. Vehicles entering the 6th Street parking garage after 7 pm park for free. Metered city parking is also available along 6th Street, Wilshire Boulevard, and neighboring side streets during select hours. But please read signs carefully; vehicles in violation will be towed.

There will be a sign-up sheet on Saturday to coordinate those with cars who are willing to take people to the reception and those looking for a ride.
